Goodwood MetalCraft Limited started making high quality stainless steel tableware and catering equipment in 1960. Following from the use of spiked carving forks, Goodwood MetalCraft, with its parent company Dexam International developed the principal further to produce a spiked carving dish, to more successfully hold a joint of meat while it is carved.

The carving dish, known as the “Chichester Spiked Carving Dish” has now been manufactured at our Chichester works for over 50 years and over 25,000 have been produced and sold.

Manufactured from 18/8 brushed stainless steel with eight riveted 1cm long stainless steel spikes, the product combines the presswork and machining capabilities of Goodwood MetalCraft.



The dish is still being marketed today by Dexam www.dexam.co.uk as part of its “Swift Range” and is stocked by many leading department stores and catering specialists nationally.

The longevity of this product is a testament to the integrity of the design, the customer focus of the company and the enduring quality of the manufacture.

This product compliments Goodwood MetalCrafts “Tawlite” range of stainless steel hollowware for the catering and hospital markets.
